




Monsoon Watch

- The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) continues to pass through Lat. 25.0°N / Long. 60.0°E, Lat. 25.0° N/ Long. 65.0°E, Udaipur, Guna, Satna, Ranchi, Berhampore, Jalpaiguri and Gangtok.
- Condition are favourable for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of Rajasthan; remaining parts of Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand and West Bengal & Sikkim and some parts of Bihar and east Uttar Pradesh during next 2 days.
- Yesterday, southwest monsoon was vigorous over Odisha and Chhattisgarh and active over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Gangetic West Bengal, Vidarbha, coastal Andhra Pradesh and Kerala.

Salient Advisories for the kharif Crops

Based on the realized and expected rainfall, following salient advisories for the crops have been prepared.

- Arunachal Pradesh: Undertake transplanting of WRC (Wetland Rice Cultivation) rice.
- Meghalaya: Continue nursery sowing of sali rice.
- Mizoram: Continue sowing of maize, groundnut and nursery sowing of *jhum* rice.
- Manipur: Continue sowing of cucurbitaceous vegetables, maize, and groundnut and nursery sowing of rice.
- **Tripura:** Continue nursery sowing of aman rice
- West Bengal: Continue nursery sowing of aman rice
- **Odisha:** Postpone nursery sowing of rice and sowing of maize and sowing of direct seeded rice, arhar, groundnut, cotton and pulses as to very heavy to heavy rainfall rainfall is expected in next 48 hours. Also provide drainage for already sown *kharif* rice nursery.
- **Kerala:** Postpone transplanting of *virippu* rice and sowing of direct seeded rice, planting of banana, and sowing/ transplanting of vegetables as heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours. Also provide drainage for already planted banana and vegetable fields.
- **Coastal Andhra Pradesh:** Continue land preparation and nursery sowing of rice and sowing of bajra and groundnut.
- Raylaseema: Undertake land preparation and sowing of groundnut.
- Telangana: Postpone sowing of maize, sorghum, groundnut, cotton and castor as heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours.
- **Coastal Karnataka:** Postpone nursery sowing *kharif* rice as heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours.
- North Interior Karnataka: Undertake sowing of black gram, green gram, red gram, groundnut and sorghum.
- South Interior Karnataka: Undertake sowing of black gram, green gram, maize, red gram, groundnut and sesamum.
- **Tamil Nadu:** Undertake transplanting of *kuruvai* rice and nursery sowing of rice for SRI cultivation in Cauvery Delta Region.
- Maharashtra: As there was widespread rain in Konkan and widespread rainfall with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours, farmers in the region are advised to postpone nursery sowing of kharif rice and finger millet. Also drain out excess water from already sown kharif rice nursery.
- Undertake sowing of *kharif* jowar, groundnut, soybean, cotton in Madhya Maharashtra. In Marathwada, postpone sowing of kharif jowar, soybean, cotton, red gram, green gram and black gram as heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours.
- In Vidarbha, postpone sowing of jowar, soybean, cotton, red gram, sunflower as heavy to very heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours.
- Gujarat: Undertake land preparation and nursery sowing of rice and sowing of bajra, maize, groundnut, cotton, pigeon pea and green gram.
- Bihar: Nursery sowing of kharif rice, complete sowing of direct seeded rice, sowing of kharif maize and vegetables.
- Jharkhand: Undertake land preparation and nursery sowing of rice and land preparation and sowing of soybean, maize, urad, arhar and *kharif* vegetables viz.bhindi, bean, French bean, tomato, cauliflower, cabbage etc.
- Madhya Pradesh: Undertake land preparation and nursery sowing of rice and sowing of soybean, and pulses in south M.P. and land preparation for sowing of *kharif* crops in rest part of M.P.
- Chattisgarh: Postpone nursery sowing of rice and sowing of soybean, maize, jowar and groundnut as heavy to very heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours.
- Jammu & Kashmir (Sub Tropical Zone): Undertake land preparation and sowing of maize, sowing of direct seeded rice and transplanting of brinjal, chilli and cauliflower. In Intermediate Zone, sowing of maize, bajra and nursery raising of rice.
- Himachal Pradesh : Nursery sowing of rice and vegetables.
- Uttarakhand: Undertake transplanting of rice, sowing of soybean and French bean.
- Uttar Pradesh: Undertake land preparation and sowing of maize, jowar, groundnut arhar, moong and urad and nursery sowing of rice.
- Rajasthan: In East Rajasthan, farmers are advised land preparation and sowing of *kharif* crops utilizing recent rainfall. In West Rajasthan land preparation for sowing of *kharif* crops







- **Realised Rainfall: Realised Rainfall:** Significant rainfall occurred in most of the districts in Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand; Faridkot, Fatehgarh Saheb, Mohali districts in Punjab, Chandigarh district of Haryana, Kathua, Rajouri district in Jammu & Kashmir; Ajmer, Chittorgarh, Jaipur, Kota, Pratapgarh, Rajasmand, Sawai Madhopur, Tonk districts in East Rajasthan; Ambedkarnagar, Balrampur, Bahraich, Barabanki, Faizabad, Hardoi, Kheri, Lucknow, Sitapur, Sahuji Maharajnagar Unnao districts in East Uttar Pradesh; Badaun, Barelly, Bijnor, Lalitpur, Moraadabad, Pilibhit, Shahjahanpur districts in West Uttar Pradesh. Weather remained mainly dry over rest parts of the region.
- Weather Forecast: Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over western Himalayan region, Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan.
- Weather Outlook: Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over western Himalayan region. Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Rajasthan, Punjab and Haryana and at a few places over rest northwest India.
- Advisory:
- In Sub Tropical Zone of Jammu & Kashmir, farmers are advised to undertake sowing of maize, sowing of direct seeded rice and transplanting of brinjal, chilli and cauliflower.
- Farmers in Intermediate Zone of Jammu & Kashmir are advised to undertake sowing of maize, bajra and nursery raising of rice crop. Also in Cold Arid Zone of Jammu & Kashmir, farmers are advised to continue transplanting of cruciferous crops and onion (middle belts), tomato, capsicum and chilli in the lower belts.
- ➢ In Sub-Humid Zone of Himachal Pradesh, farmers are advised to undertake nursery sowing of rice and vegetables.
- In Bhabar and Tarai Zone of Uttarakhand, farmers are advised to undertake transplanting of rice and sowing of soybean and French bean. Also, in Sub-Humid and Sub-Tropic Zone of Uttarakhand, farmers are advised to dig pits for planting of new orchards and nursery of late variety of rice crop.
- In Central Plain Zone of Uttar Pradesh, farmers are advised to undertake land preparation and sowing of maize, jowar, groundnut and nursery sowing of rice. Also, in Western Plain Zone of Uttar Pradesh, farmers are advised to start sowing of arhar, moong and urad and for green fodder jowar, bajra and undertake nursery sowing of basmati rice.
- Farmers in Delhi are advised to undertake nursery sowing of rice. Also prepare nursery for early cauliflower and brinjal. Sowing of pigeon pea, baby corn (HM-4) and sweet corn can be done during this week. Undertake field preparation for sowing of guar, bajara, maize, cluster bean, spinach, amaranthus and lady's finger.
- Farmers in Western and Central Plain Zone in Punjab are advised to start transplanting of rice.
- ▶ Farmers in Eastern Zone in Haryana are advised to undertake transplanting of rice in the main field.
- In East Rajasthan, farmers are advised land preparation and sowing of kharif crops utilizing recent rainfall and in West Rajasthan land preparation for sowing of kharif crops.
- Stages of major crops are mentioned in Annexure I.
- Varieties are mentioned in Annexure II

• Animal Husbandry

In Intermediate Zone of Jammu & Kashmir, it is advised to provide clean drinking water to the animals. Vaccination against FMD and Hemorrhagic septicemia in cows, buffaloes, sheeps and goats should be done. Do not vaccinate pregnant animals. Keep litter dry using sodium bentonite to avoid coccidiosis problems.

CENTRAL INDIA [M.P., CHHATTISGARH]

- **Realised Rainfall:** Significant rainfall occurred in all districts of Chhattisgarh except Jashpurnagar, Kanker, Korba, Koriya and Raigarh, in all districts of East Madhya Pradesh except Chhatarpur, Chindwara, Katni, Panna, Rewa, Sidhi and Tikamgarh, in all districts of west Madhya Pradesh except Alirajpur, Badwani, Bhind, Bhopal, Burhanpur, Datia, Harda, Jhabua, Khandwa, Khargaon, Mandsaur, Morena, Raigarh, Sheopur and Katani.
- Weather forecast: Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over Chhattisgarh during next 48 hours and decrease thereafter. Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Madhya Pradesh during next 48 hours and increase thereafter.
- Weather Warning: Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Chhattisgarh during next 48 hours.
- Advisories:

- ➤ In Chhattisgarh, postpone nursery sowing of rice and sowing of soybean, maize, jowar and groundnut as heavy to very heavy rainfall is expected during next 48 hours. Also farmers are advised to make proper drainage arrangement to avoid water lodging in the fields of onion, sugarcane and vegetables. They are also advised to give mechanical support to fruit plants like papaya etc.
- As there is widespread rain in Kymore Plateau and Satpura Hills Zone, Gird Zone, Bundelkhand Zone and Vindhya Plateau Zone of Madhya Pradesh, farmers are advised to prepare rice nursery, field preparation for direct sowing of rice, maize, jowar, soybean and vegetables.
- ➢ Farmers in Bundelkhand Zone of Madhya Pradesh are advised that present weather condition is ideal for grafting and pruning in fruit trees like jamun, anola, guava and mango. Farmers are also advised to start nursery sowing of *kharif* onion.
- ➢ In Jhabua Hill Zone of Madhya Pradesh, farmers are advised to prepare rice nursery, onion nursery and sowing of soybean. Also undertake planting of ginger and turmeric.
- ➢ In North Hills Zone of Chhattisgarh, farmers are advised to prepare nursery for rice, vegetables and seasonal flowers. Also undertake land preparation and sowing of arhar and soybean.
- Stages of major crops are mentioned in Annexure I.
- ➢ Varieties are mentioned in Annexure II

• ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & POULTRY

Dairy farmers in Bundelkhand Zone of Madhya Pradesh are advised to give vaccination to animals to protect them from FMD.

EAST INDIA [JHARKHAND, BIHAR, ORISSA, WEST BENGAL & SIKKIM]

- **Realised Rainfall:** Significant rainfall occurred in all districts of Sikkim and in most of the districts Sub Himalayan West Bengal (except North Dinajpur, South Dinajpur and Malda), Gangetic West Bengal (except East Midnapore, West Midnapore, Kolkata, Murshidabad, Nadia and Purulia), Jharkhand (except Chatra, Dumka, Garhwa, Giridih, Godda, East Singbhum, Hazaribagh, Jamtara, Koderma, Palamau, Ramgarh, Sahebganj and Saraikela), Odisha (except Angul, Balasore, Deogarh, Ganjam, Jagatsingpur, Khurda,Mayurbhanj, Nayagarh and Sonepur) and also in Araria, Kathihar, Kishanganj, Madhepura, Madhubani, Purnea, Saharsa and Supaul districts of Bihar.
- Weather Forecast: Rain / thundershowers would occur at most places over Odisha during next 24 hours and decrease thereafter. Rain / thundershowers would occur at many places over Jharkhand and Gangetic West Bengal during the period. Rain / thundershowers would occur at a few places over Bihar and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during the period.
- Weather Warning: Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Odisha during next 48 hours.
- Weather Outlook: Rain / thundershowers would occur at a few places over the States of the region.

• Advisories:

- ➤ As there was good rainfall during last couple of weeks in most of the districts of West Bengal, Jharkhand and Sikkim, farmers are advised to postpone irrigation to the crops in these States.
- As rain is likely to occur at most places during next 24 hours along with heavy to very heavy rainfall at one or two places in Odisha during next 48 hours, farmers are advised to postpone irrigation, sowing, intercultural operation and also application of fertilizers and plant protection measures to the crops. Farmers are also advised to arrange for adequate drainage to avoid stagnation of water in crop fields.
- > In view of likely occurrence of rain at many places in Jharkhand and Gangetic West Bengal, farmers are advised to postpone irrigation, intercultural operation and also application of fertilizers and plant protection measures to the crops.
- Taking the advantage of recent monsoon rain, farmers in North West Alluvial Plain Zone of Bihar are advised to complete direct sowing of long duration rice varieties. Farmers are also advised to undertake land preparation and nursery sowing of long duration varieties of rice, and also intercropping of lobia and rice bean.
- In South Bihar Alluvial Zone and North East Alluvial Plain Zone of Bihar, farmers are advised to undertake nursery sowing of rice, sowing of maize and small millets, vegetable crops like bottle gourd, sponge gourd, bitter gourd, ridge gourd, cucumber, cowpea and okra and *kharif* fodder like jowar, maize, dinanath, kalai, cowpea.
- ➢ Farmers in Terai Zone, New Alluvial Zone, Laterite and Red Soil Zone of West Bengal are advised for nursery sowing of *aman* rice utilizing recent monsoon rain.
- Farners are advised to undertake sowing of pigeon-pea in New Alluvial Zone and sowing of wet seeded rice in Coastal Saline Zone of West Bengal.

- ➢ Farmers in Jharkhand are advised to undertake land preparation and nursery sowing of rice and also sowing of soybean, maize, urad, arhar and *kharif* vegetables *viz*. bhindi, bean, French bean, tomato, cauliflower, cabbage etc. and planting of ginger and turmeric.
- Stages of major crops are mentioned in Annexure I.
- Varieties are mentioned in Annexure II

• Animal Husbandry

Farmers in North West Alluvial Plain Zone of Bihar are advised to carry out vaccination of cattles against the black quarter, anthrax and other diseases during this season.

NORTHEAST INDIA [ARUNACHAL PRADESH, NMM&T, ASSAM, MEGHALAYA]

- **Realised Rainfall:** Significant rainfall occurred in Barpeta, Baksa, Cachar, Dhubri, Goalpara, Kokrajhar, Dibrugarh, Sibsagar, Tinsukia, Karimganj, Udalguri, Morigaon, Nagaon and Lakhimpur districts of Assam, East Kameng, East Siang, Tirap, Upper Siang, Upper Subansiri, West Kameng and West Siang districts of Arunachal Pradesh, East Khasi Hills, Jaintia Hills, Ri-Bhoi and West Garo Hills districts of Meghalaya, Aizwal, Champhai, Lawngtlai, Serchhip, Mamit and Saiha districts of Mizoram, Dimapur, Kohima, Phek and Zunheboto districts of Nagaland and North Tripura and West Tripura districts of Tripura.
- Weather Forecast: Rain / thundershowers would occur at a few places over the States of the region during the period.
- Rain / thundershowers would occur at a few places over the States of the region.
- Advisories:
- Taking the advantage of recent monsoon rain, farmers in Assam are advised to continue nursery sowing of sali rice. Select long duration rice varieties for lowland areas and medium duration rice varieties for medium lowland areas. Farmers in Hill Zone, Lower Brahmaputra Valley Zone and Central Brahmaputra Valley Zone of Assam are advised to continue land preparation and sowing of arhar.
- Farmers in Sub-Tropical Hill Zone of Arunachal Pradesh are advised to continue transplanting of WRC rice and mature seedlings of tomato and brinjal.
- Farmers in Sub Tropical Plain Zone of Manipur are advised to continue seed bed preparation and sowing for *kharif* rice and continue land preparation for transplanting. Also continue sowing of black gram, cowpea, okra and nursery raising of early cauliflower in the upland area. Re-sowing of cowpea, okra may be followed in those fields in which young plants had been affected due to rain.
- ➢ Farmers in Mild Tropical Hill Zone of Mizoram are advised to continue nursery sowing of rice for low land. Also continue sowing of cucurbits, French bean, ginger and turmeric utilizing recent monsoon rain.
- ➢ Farmers in Temperate Sub Alpine Zone of Meghalaya are advised to continue nursery sowing of *sali* rice. Transplant rice in the main field when seedlings are 25-30 days old.
- > Farmers in Mild Tropical Plain Zone of Tripura are advised to continue nursery sowing of *aman* rice. Farmers are also advised to undertake land preparation and sowing of groundnut in upland and maize in medium upland.
- The prevalent weather in Mild Tropical Hill Zone of Nagaland is favourable for the development of stem borer in *kharif* maize. Farmers are advised to monitor the crop and apply appropriate plant protection measures on a non-rainy day.
- Stages of major crops are mentioned in Annexure I.
- ➤ Varieties are mentioned in Annexure II

• Animal Husbandry

- Farmers in the states of the region are advised to deworm and carry out immunizations against FMD, HS and BQ in cattle & buffaloes and swine fever in pigs during this period. Also, vaccinate against Ranikhet disease in one week old chicks and against Gamboro disease in two weeks old chicks.
- ➤ In Mild Tropical Plain Zone of Tripura, damp litter and high moisture due to heavy rain may lead to *Coccidiosis* in chicken; so avoid dampness in the shed. Piglets are susceptible for swine fever due to change in weather and feed. The disease may be controlled by Furazolidone, streptomycin etc.

WEST INDIA [GOA, MAHARASHTRA, GUJARAT]

- **Realised Rainfall:** Most of the districts in Maharashtra State (except Jalgaon and Solapur districts in Madhya Maharashtra, Beed district in Marathwada and Gondia district in East Viadarbha) received significant rainfall during last week. Significant rainfall occurred in Ahmedabad, Anand, Broach, Dangs, Narmada, Navsari, Surat, Tapi, Valsad, Amreli, Bhavnagar, Diu, Jamnagar, Junagarh, Porbandar and Rajkot districts of Gujarat.
- Weather Forecast: Rain / thundershowers would occur at most places over Konkan and Goa during the period. Rain / thundershowers would occur at most places over Vidarbha during next 24 hours and decrease

thereafter. Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada and at a few places over Gujarat during the period.

- Warning : Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Vidarba and heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Konkan & Goa during next 48 hours.
- Weather Outlook: Rain / thundershowers would occur at many places over the States of the region.

• Advisories:

- ➤ As rain is likely to occur at most places in Konkan and Goa and Vidarbha along with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall during next 24 hours, farmers in these regions are advised to postpone irrigation, intercultural operation and application of fertilizers and plant protection measures. Farmers are also advised to postpone nursery sowing of *kharif* rice and finger millet in Konkan and Goa and sowing of jowar, soybean, cotton, red gram, sunflower in Vidarbha and nursery sowing of rice in Gondia, Bhandara, Gadchiroli and Chandrapur districts in East Vidarbha. Farmers are also advised to arrange adequate drainage to avoid stagnation of water in the crop fields.
- As most of the districts in Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada received significant rainfall during last week and rain is also expected at many places during the period, farmers are advised to complete the preparatory tillage and start the sowing of *kharif* jowar, bajra, groundnut, soybean and cotton in Madhya Maharashtra and *kharif* jowar, soybean, cotton, red gram, green gram and black gram in Marathwada. In view of likely rainfall at many places, farmers are advised to postpone irrigation, intercultural operation and application of fertilizers and plant protection measures.
- Farmers in Gujarat State are advised to postpone irrigation as rain is likely to occur over this region during coming days.
- Farmers in most parts Gujarat State (Banaskantha, Baroda, Dahod, Gandhinagar, Mehsana, Panchmahal, Patan and Sabarkantha districts) are advised to undertake land preparation and nursery sowing of rice and sowing of groundnut, cotton, bajra, maize, pigeon pea and green gram.
- Cloudy and humid weather is favourable for attack of aphids and jassids on early sown irrigated cotton in Western Maharashtra Scarcity Zone; spray Confidor @ 5 ml or Profenofos @ 20 ml per 10 litre of water after current spells of rain.
- Due to high temperature and humidity, there are chances of attack of thrips and white fly in brinjal, tomato and okra in South Gujarat Heavy Rainfall Zone; farmers are advised to spray the crops with neem oil @ 0.5% or Methyl –O – Dematone @ 0.2 on a non-rainy day.
- Stages of the crops are mentioned in Annexure I.
- Animal Husbandry
 - Farmers in Gujarat are advised to vaccinate animals by HF vaccination against FMD and BQ to avoid disease outbreak during monsoon season.

SOUTH INDIA [TN, AP, KERALA, KARNATAKA, LAKSHADWEEP, ANDAMAN & NICOBAR ISLANDS]

- **Realised Rainfall:** Significant rainfall occurred in all the districts of Kerala; most of the districts of Coastal Karnataka, Belgaum, Bidar, Bijapur, Gadag, Gulbarga in North Interior Karnataka, Chickmagalur, Kodagu and Shimoga in South Interior Karnataka, Coimbatore, Kancheepuram, Kanyakumari, Karaikal, Nilgiris, Thiruvallur and Vellore in Tamil Nadu, most of the districts in Telangana and Coastal Andhra Pradesh except East Godavari and Nellore.
- **Rainfall Forecast:** Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over Kerala and Coastal Karnataka. Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over north Andhra Pradesh during next 24 hours and decrease thereafter, at a few places over North interior Karnataka and at one or two places over south interior Karnataka, south Andhra Pradesh and Tamilnadu.
- Weather Warning: Heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Telangana coastal Karnataka and Kerala during next 48 hours.
- Weather Outlook: Subdued rainfall activity over rest of south peninsular India.

• Advisories:

- Heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Telangana, coastal Karnataka and Kerala during next 48 hours, farmers are advised to arrange drainage to banana and vegetables.
- Farmers in Southern Zone and Northern Zone of Kerala are advised to undertake transplanting of *virippu* rice and sowing of direct seeded *virippu* rice after the current spells of rain.
- > Farmers in the Southern Zone of Kerala are advised planting of banana, intercropping in coconut gardens after the current spells of rain.
- Farmers in the Coastal Zone of Karnataka are advised to continue field preparation and nursery sowing of *kharif* rice after the current spells of rain.
- Farmers in the Hill Zone of Karnataka are advised to undertake sowing of cotton.

- ➢ Farmers in Eastern Dry Zone of Karnataka are advised to prepare field and undertake sowing of red gram and ragi utilizing the realized rainfall.
- ➢ Farmers in the North Transition Zone of Karnataka are advised to undertake sowing of maize, sorghum, green gram, soybean, groundnut, chilli and cotton.
- Farmers in Southern Transition Zone of Karnataka are advised to undertake sowing of green gram, maize, Bt. cotton, red gram, sesamum and groundnut (bunch type).
- Farmers in the Cauvery Delta Zone of Tamil Nadu are advised to undertake transplanting of *kuruvai* rice and nursery sowing of rice for SRI cultivation.
- Farmers in the Western Zone of Tamil Nadu are advised to undertake propping eight months old sugarcane and five months old banana crops to avoid lodging due to strong winds.
- ➢ Farmers in the North Coastal Zone of Andhra Pradesh are advised to undertake sowing of and of bajra and planting of sugarcane.
- Farmers in the Krishna Godavari Zone of Andhra Pradesh are advised to take up sowing of cotton and pulses.
- Farmers in the Scarce Rainfall Zone of Andhra Pradesh are advised to undertake land preparation and sowing of groundnut, pigeon pea cotton, castor, maize and jowar.
- Farmers in the Southern Telangana Zone of Andhra Pradesh are advised to undertake land preparation and sowing of *kharif* crops like cotton, jowar, maize, castor, groundnut, pigeon pea, green gram etc. after current spells of rain.
- Prevailing hot and humid conditions are favourable for sucking pest incidence in Bt. cotton in Scarce Rainfall Zone of Andhra Pradesh. Farmers are advised to spray Monocrotophos + water @ 1:4 or Imidacloprid 200 SL + water @ 1:20 after 20, 40 and 60 DAS for controlling sucking pest.
- Stages of major crops are mentioned in Annexure I.
- Varieties are mentioned in Annexure II

• Animal Husbandry:

- ➢ Farmers in the Problem Area Zone of Kerala are advised to vaccinate the animals against haemorrhagic septicaemia since there is possibility of outbreak of the disease in milch animals during monsoon.
- Farmers in the Scarce Rainfall Zone of Andhra Pradesh are advised to undertake vaccination of animals against FMD, Brucellosis, Haemorrahagic Septicaemia, Anthrax and small ruminants against PPR and Sheep and Goat Pox.
