February 2016 Summary:

The Atlantic high pressure ridge

and occasional low level

troughs dominated the weather pattern. On February 5th heavy showers and periods of rain from a trough system resulted in flooding in the north-east of Saint Vincent. However, a mere 1.9 mm was recorded in the Arnos Vale area at the E. T Joshua station. That station recorded 31.5mm rainfall for February 2016, which was 58.8mm less than the February 30 year average (using E.T Joshua Airport 1981-2010 period average).

(Figure 1. Stations- Rainfall (mm)) Within the last 9 days, 48.3% of total rainfall was recorded. There were 5 consecutive days with rainfall less than 1mm.

Maximum temperature was 31.8° C in the Richmond area (see table 1). **Sea swells** were moderate to rough in open waters due to moderate to fresh breezes. This resulted in advisories for sea bathers and small craft operators. **Maximum gusts** in the Arnos Vale area were recorded on the 24^{th} as 27 knots ($\sim 50 \text{km/h}$).

Air Temperature- Above normal to normal Sea Surface Temperature- 0°C - 1 °C above average.




Figure 2 Regional Precipitation Outlook March-April-May 2016 *Read more.*

Average rainfall for **March** is 82.8mm with 16 rain-days (using E.T Joshua Airport 1981-2010 period average). The average relative humidity is around 74%. Strong high level winds are expected to reduce shower activity. Continue to conserve water and practice soil preservation methods.
